Writing opportunities:

Letters, diaries, cartoon strips, song lyrics and newspaper articles. The children will have a go at writing a modern retelling of a scene.

The children will be focusing on the use of synonyms and antonyms, manipulation of sentences for effect and cohesive devices.

Identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood Describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported

To recognise the impact of exercise on the heart and record results.

To explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.


