Tapestry Policy

September 2023

We ensure that all children attending Nursery and Reception have a personal Learning Journey which records photos, observations and comments, in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage, to build up a record of each child's achievements during their time with us. This is done through an online platform called Tapestry. Class communication and memos are also shared through Tapestry.

In Year 1, Tapestry is used as a platform to continue to share learning with parents/carers and to send class communication and memos.

Procedures

- We use an online Learning Journey system (Tapestry), allowing staff and parents to access the information from any device via a personal, password-protected login.
- Staff access allows input of new observations and photos or amendment of existing observations and photos.
- Observations input into the Tapestry system are moderated by a senior member of staff before being added to the child's Learning Journey.
- Parents logging into the system are only able to see their own child's Learning Journey.
- Parents are asked to sign a consent form giving permission for their child's image to appear in other children's Learning Journeys, and to protect images of other children that may appear in any photos contained in their child's Learning Journey (appendix 1.)
- We will try wherever possible to allocate "Tapestry time" per week to each member of staff to enable them to upload observations. Any overflow will have to be completed in staff's own time.
- Tapestry is not used as a general communication tool between school and home. A child's learning journey is a document recording their learning and development and at times will be used for class communication.
- Parents must contact staff through the whole school channels for any dayto-day matters, e.g. absence, lost property, etc. This being speaking to a class teacher on the classroom door or contacting the school office.
- Staff are not to communicate with parents via Tapestry and parents should not communicate with staff via Tapestry.

Security

- The Tapestry online Learning journey system is hosted on secure dedicated servers based in the UK.
- Access to information stored on Tapestry can only be gained by unique user id and password.
- Parents can only see their own child's information and are unable to login to view other children's Learning Journeys.
- Consent and permission forms have been signed prior to using Tapestry (appendix 1.)
