Literacy

Having explored the world of Peter Rabbit we will be writing the story of The Radish Robber and innovating our own story inspired by Peter Rabbit.

We will be focusing on the key skills of::

- Saying, and holding in memory whilst writing, simple sentences which make sense
- Writing simple sentences that can be read by themselves and others
- Using punctuation to demarcate simple sentences (capital letters and full stops)
- Orally composing every sentence before writing
- Re-reading every sentence to check it makes sense
- Using and to link and join clauses

Science

In Science we will continue our learning about materials this will include;

- distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
- identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- describe the simple physical properties of a variety

RE/PSHCE

We will be learning to unitise and coin recognition (Unit 8) We will exploring the numbers 11- 19.
